Develop the READJUST Observatory with a policy tracker tool, an inequality index, and an equality self-assessment tool

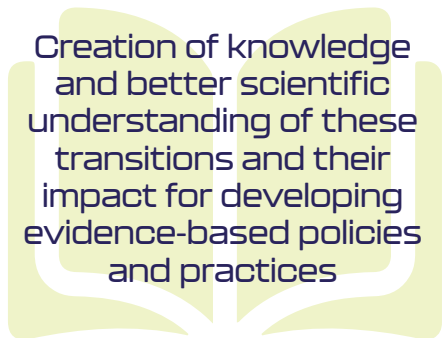
